### **Registration Information 2022/2023**

Thank you for your interest in The School of Grace Preschool. We are a half-day, Christian, parent-participatory preschool serving children ages 6 months through 5 years. The preschool operates from September through May.

The registration period is tiered:		
<ul> <li>January 4<sup>th</sup>: Registration is open for current and former families, along with</li> </ul>		

- January 4<sup>th</sup>: Registration is open for current and former families, along with Grace Lutheran Church members. Forms will be processed on January 11<sup>th</sup> and families will be notified regarding the status of their application.
- January 11<sup>th</sup>: Registration is open for all families. All forms will be processed as they are received.
- Registration will continue until all classes are filled.

#### Additional Notes:

- Registration fees are not applicable to tuition and are non-refundable unless the family moves to another town, notifying The School of Grace in writing prior to July 1, 2022.
- September tuition is due at <u>Parent Orientation</u> in August 2022.
- Families whose tuition is more than \$500 per month will receive a <u>5% discount on tuition</u> (not including registration fees).
- <u>Children do NOT need to be fully potty-trained</u> by the beginning of the school year.
- The School of Grace allocates <u>one space in each class for a child from a refugee family,</u> referred by Lutheran Services Carolinas.
- The School of Grace allocates one space in each class for a child with special needs. In order to qualify
  as such, an active IFSP (for children 6 months 2 years) or an IEP (ages 3 5 years) must be in place.
   We support and encourage parents to seek out the services provided by Wake County through Health
  and Human Resources or Project Enlightenment.
- Tours are recommended prior to registration. Contact the Director to schedule a tour.
